The RNLI – what does it stand for?



The Royal National Lifeboat Institution has a clear aim: it exists to save lives at sea. The charity provides a 24/7 search and rescue lifeboat service all year round and most of the people that carry out the rescues are volunteers. There are over 5,600 lifeboat crew members in the UK and Republic of Ireland, forming crews at more than 238 lifeboat stations. These brave and selfless people aided 12,903 people in 2021.

The RNLI introduced a seasonal lifeguard service in 2001, which now patrols over 245 UK and Channel Island beaches. The lifeguards aided 40,762 people in 2021 – and helped many more people through offering prevention advice.

Despite their best efforts, around 140 people lose their lives at the UK and Irish coasts each year. So the RNLI aims to halve coastal fatalities in the UK and Republic of Ireland using safety initiatives. A key part of this is the **Respect the Water** campaign, which warns people that British and Irish waters are dangerously unpredictable.

Time and time again, people need the RNLI's help, from the shore to the open sea. To continue providing a ring of safety around the UK and Republic of Ireland, the charity relies on the crucial efforts of volunteers – be they crew members, safety officers or fundraisers – and the generosity of its supporters, whose voluntary contributions keep the charity afloat.
